**Note:** Clients with data hosting contracts do not need to perform the update because ChildPlus has already installed it for you.

## Update Enhancements

ChildPlus has optimized the automatic updating process to minimize the number of files that are downloaded. ChildPlus DataEngine now takes significantly less time to update itself and can update itself over a slower Internet or WAN connection.



**Note:** If ChildPlus DataEngine is not able to update itself after an update has been applied to the database, this is most likely because the user does not have full control of the ChildPlus folder. The user running ChildPlus DataEngine must have full control of the ChildPlus folder, however, they do NOT need to be an Administrator or have any other special permission.

# Enhancements & Fixes

ChildPlus DataEngine version 1.23 includes several enhancements and fixes.

## Enhancements

Enhancements to ChildPlus include improved performance throughout the system for those customers who are accessing ChildPlus over the Internet. In addition, ChildPlus DataEngine is now compatible with Microsoft Windows Vista™.

### Improved Web Performance

Customers accessing ChildPlus over the Internet (ChildPlus Hosted Users) should notice small performance improvements on every screen and report in the system.

### Windows Vista

ChildPlus DataEngine is now compatible with Microsoft Windows Vista.

## Fixes

The following table lists the fixes that ChildPlus incorporated into the release of version 1.23:

ChildPlus DataEngine Fixes	
Screen	Description
Enrollment	When you access the <b>Enrollment</b> screen and view the record of a participant who has status of <i>terminated</i> , ChildPlus displays the <b>Terminate Reason</b> in the <b>Enrollment History</b> box.
Immunizations	Users with <b>View Access</b> can now access the <b>Immunizations</b> screen.
Immunizations Setup	You can now restrict users from accessing the <b>Immunizations Setup</b> screen by assigning their security group with <b>No Access</b> .
License Count	Children already enrolled in one program can be enrolled in additional programs without using up an additional license.
Select Existing Person button	You can now set up security preferences ( <b>No Access</b> or <b>Full Access</b> ) for the <b>Select Existing Person</b> button. This button is available when you attempt to look up a person in ChildPlus and either of the following occurs: you check the <b>Search for Existing Person</b> checkbox or ChildPlus finds a match that closely resembles the name you are searching for.

# Reports

ChildPlus both enhanced and modified existing reports for the release of 1.23. Because many of these fixes were minor, we have only listed changes that directly affect users in this document.

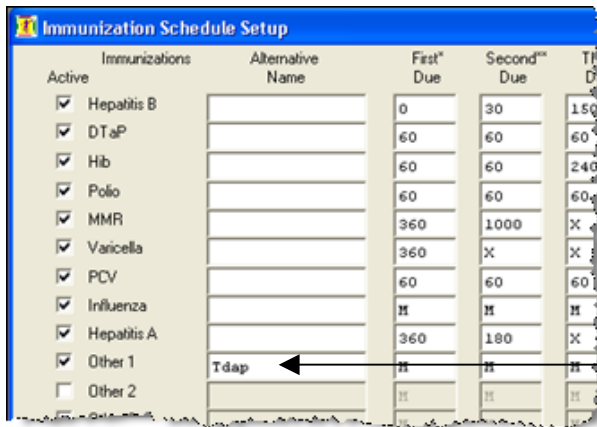
## Modifications to Reports

The following table lists the different reports that ChildPlus modified for version 1.23:

Requirements Assessment	3020	Assessment	Can be run as either a <b>Detail</b> or <b>Summary</b> report.
Participant CACFP Roster	2370	Attendance	Displays <b>CACFP Status</b> for adult participants.
Training Attendance Log	1315	Career Development	No longer prints information for inactive personnel.
Management Report – Disabilities	3501	Disability	No longer prints the <b>Concern Status</b> for participant's who have been diagnosed with a disability.
Participant Mailing Labels	4501	Mailing Labels	Now prints the participant's city, state, and zip code on the following label types: 5161, 5162, and 5260.
Mental Health Activity Report	3620	Mental Health Activity Record	Displays all related activities.
Contact Information	1520	Transportation	Can be run with the <b>Show Last DTaP</b> data option.

## Custom Filters

You can now create custom filters using the **Alternative Name** assigned to each immunization on the **Immunization Schedule Setup** screen. In previous releases of ChildPlus, these fields were being referenced by their default name in ChildPlus (for example, **Other 1**, **Other 2**, and **Other 3**). If you have not designated an **Alternative Name** for an immunization, however, ChildPlus will continue to use the default name.



You can now create custom filters using the **Alternative Name** assigned to each immunization (for example, **Tdap** instead of **Other 1**).

## LiveReport

The following table lists the changes that ChildPlus made to LiveReport for the release of version 1.23:

LiveReport field	Description
Next Immunization	The <b>Next Immunization</b> field now populates correctly when included on a LiveReport.
